Dear Parents,

The school received a notification today (27/2) afternoon, that a male boarder obtained positive result through a rapid test, he had been sent to hospital for treatment. The teacher who was tested preliminarily positive earlier, had now been confirmed to be COVID-19 positive by the CHP. Besides, we received the notifications from a teacher and a replacement cook yesterday, that they got positive result through rapid test, their last on-duty day were 22<sup>nd</sup> February and 23<sup>rd</sup> February respectively. The school has reported the cases to the Education Bureau and the Centre for Health Protection.

The school will be temporarily closed for 5 days from 28<sup>th</sup> February to 4<sup>th</sup> March for cleaning and disinfection. In order to protect our students from virus, we will arrange a professional cleaning company to carry out deep disinfection spraying and RAZE nano-photocatalyst coating for the whole school premise. The school will notify students and their parents as soon as possible for any update.

Our school will keep close contact with CHP and closely monitor the health conditions of our staff and students.
