**Re: The school/dormitory operation under severe epidemic situation**

25<sup>th</sup> March, 2022

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The fifth wave of the COVID-19 epidemic swept across Hong Kong in late February and early March, resulting in an exponential increase in the number of infections. Our schools have not been spared during these challenging times, 9 boarders and more than 30 staff members have been diagnosed positive with COVID-19. Fortunately, with the strong cooperation of all parties, all the confirmed boarders were able to be sent to the hospital for medical treatment, and all of them have recovered and been discharged. As for our staff, all but a few are still recovering, have recovered and returned to work.

After discussion at the inter-departmental anti-epidemic meeting on March 22, 2022, considering that there is currently no new infection in our school, medical monitoring has been completed, and the staffing has gradually stabilized, it has been decided to fully resume dormitory services, and gradually resume academic training, leisure activities and therapeutic training.

The school sincerely invites the "Rotary Club of Kai Tak" Outreach Service Team to vaccinate 6 boarders for the first dose on March 19, 2022. The process went smoothly. The outreach medical practitioner service team also agreed to vaccinate those 6 boarders for the second dose 28 days later. In addition, our Nursing Department has also contacted another team of outreach doctors to vaccinate another 12 boarders for the second dose on March 25, 2022.

Although the fifth wave of the epidemic has gradually stabilized, there are still uncertainties. Therefore, our epidemic prevention policy will not be slackened, and efforts will be made to maintain the daily care and training of boarders. During this period, the policy for boarder visit and home stay will remain unchanged until the government relaxes the

current epidemic prevention policy.

In this wave of epidemic, the school has been able to make a smooth transition. In addition to the joint efforts of the school and dormitory staff, it is also the cooperation and understanding of all parents/guardians. The school would like to sincerely thank all parents/guardians for their support.
